## Mission










# Peter Drucker: Father of Modern Management



- Many organisations (including governments) now actively integrating ICKM into daily processes adding structure to way they communicate and share information.





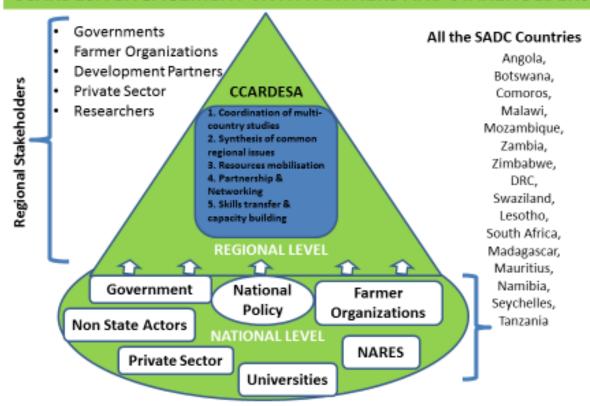

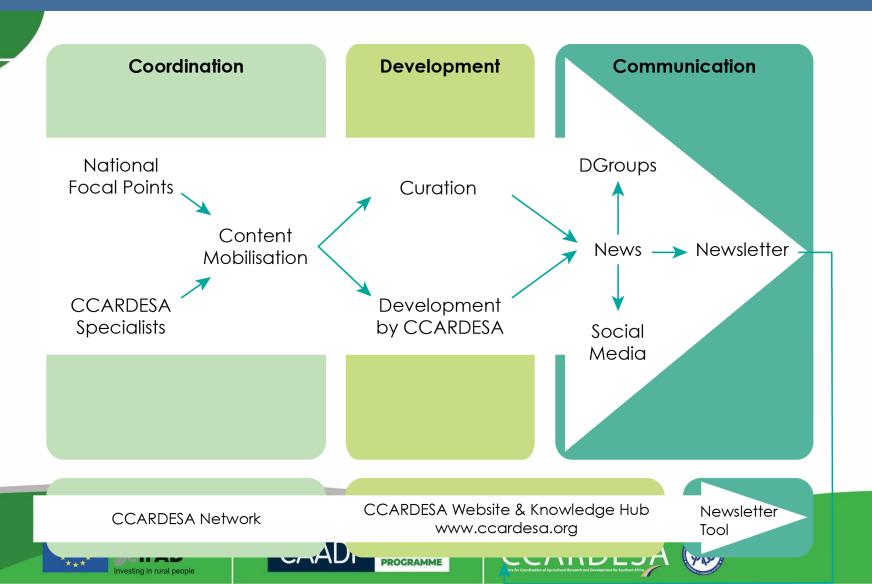








## CCARDESA's ICKM System Structure

#### **Mobile App Current Users**

The CCARDESA mobile App has increased its users from 212 last year to 870 in 2024.

The performance of Mozambique is attributed to the field trip of sensitising extension staff about the mobile app.

The four other countries received Mobile App training.
