SCORE Project site (Omulathitu village): Micro-drip irrigation systems for community and individual gardens. All the beneficiaries received training on gardening and maintenance of these systems; mentorship is still provided by SCORE and the Extension Officers to ensure sustainability.

CUVE Waters project sites: in Epyeshona "Green Village" systems to collect rainwater from roof tops ("roof catchments") and one ground catchment. The water collected is used for gardening. In the "Green Village" Lipopo a floodwater storage system with gardening can be visited.
